Most of all because you're a frog. But also because you don't have curly tail or eat garbage. I can eat garbage. Everyone says that until they eat garbage. Sorry, you can't be a pig.  I want to be an owl. Of course you want to be an owl! Being an owl is the greatest thing ever. Boy, would you love being an owl. Tell your partner what an owl does that a frog can't do  The students discussed among their neighbors about how an owl can fly and has feathers, a frog doesn't. They engaged in each other's answers and had great conversations about how an owl and frog are different.
I don't want to be a frog.  What do you want to be, then?  Not a frog. I want to be a cat or a rabbit or a pig or an owl. Something cute and warm.  I'm going to let you in on a little secret	Does anyone know what this animal may be?  • A wolf  • A dog  Does anyone know what a secret is?  • "Something that you tell a friend."  • "Something that you don't tell anyone."  • "A quiet story."
I love eating cats, I love eating rabbits and pigs and owls too. And I am pretty hungry. I might just go gobble some up right now. That's terrible! It's who I am. But guess that one thing I never eat. Badgers? Nooo, I eat badgers, lots of badgers. Frogs?	How do you think the frog feels right now?  • Scared  Would you eat a frog?  • "No, that's gross."

Bingo. Why don't you eat frogs? Because they are too wet and slimy and full of bugs. Oh. So it's good to be a frog?	How do you think the frog feels after hearing that?  • "Happy because he won't be eaten by the wolf."  • Relief  • "Finally happy that he is a frog."
Yup. I guess you can't fight nature. We are what we are. You are a fierce hunter. And you are a wet, slimy, bug-eating, very lucky frog. You should just be happy you're not a fly.	<ul> <li>What do you think the frog learned during this book?</li> <li>"He is a frog, not an owl or pig."</li> <li>"He is a frog and should want to be a frog."</li> <li>"He should be happy with being a frog."</li> <li>Why do you think that the wolf told the frog that he should be lucky he's not a fly?</li> <li>"Because frogs eat flies."</li> </ul>
What's wrong with being a fly?	How do you think the frog felt at the end of the book?  • "Happy to be a frog."  • "Happy to eat the fly."
